

Perched on a hilltop with panoramic views across Sydney Harbour, this once irregular shaped 1970's house was completely transformed to create a streamlined contemporary residence. By articulating the plan and adopting a limited neutral palette of limestone flooring and timber veneer joinery, the outdated angular elements of the original house have been removed to create an interior with a new sophisticated elegance. This high-end development is a fine example of what can be achieved by transforming an outdated house into a modern residence with minimalist detailing and flawless interior finishes.
