

The home was thoughtfully designed within CDC constraints, eliminating the need for a council DA. Several mature trees were required to be preserved, and their placement shaped the form and layout of the residence. This modern three-level home presents a striking street façade of white render and timber cladding visually connecting to the bark of the trees, positioned with a generous side setback that creates a wide, tree-lined entry.

The living level offers entertaining space at the front of the site with city views, while the main living dining kitchen area opens onto a north-facing rear yard with immaculate lawn, swimming pool and landscaped gardens. The upper level includes a master suite plus three bedrooms and bathrooms, with a private guest suite conveniently located on the main living level.

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
